1. Crime Summary

See attachments. The department responded to 939 requests for service during the month of January. Community Service responded to 103 requests for service.

2. Community Service

- *MCHS, took report of a student making suicidal comments.*

- *Dealt with several youth in conflict issues at Sunset and Ridgeview.*
- *MCHS, took a student shopping for Christmas, donations provided by members of the Department's Investigations/SRO section.*
- *MCHS, investigated hit and run in parking lot.*
- *Assisted ACET with information received about a stolen gun.*
- *CMS, several students in a mental health crisis, screened by Mind Springs.*


