



TO ALL REGISTERED VOTERS IN THE CITY OF CRAIG:

The ballot for the April 2, 2019 general municipal election originally mailed to voters did not contain a place to vote for any write-in candidates. The filing deadline is March 27, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. for write-in candidates to declare their candidacy in the election. Voters may want to delay marking their ballots until after the March 27th filing deadline for write-in candidates.

If voters are confident that they are going to vote for named candidates printed on the ballots they received, they should feel free to mark and return those ballots according to the instructions with the ballot.

If voters know or are unsure if they will want to vote for a write-in candidate:

They should **NOT** mark or return the ballots they originally received.

They will need to receive and mark a replacement ballot to vote. Voters can request the Moffat County Clerk and Recorder to mail them a replacement ballot. To request a mailed replacement ballot, call 970-824-9120 by Monday, March 25 at 3:00 pm and a replacement ballot will be mailed to the requestor. Voters can get a replacement ballot by appearing in-person at the office of the Moffat County Clerk and Recorder on or after Monday, March 25 and any time up to Election Day by 7 pm. Voters do not have to bring their previous ballot to receive a replacement ballot. Unused ballots may be destroyed.

If voters have already marked and returned their ballots, Colorado law provides that they have voted in this election and cannot vote again.

To be counted, all ballots must be received by the Moffat County Clerk and Recorder or deposited in the ballot drop box located by the East entrance of the Moffat County Courthouse at 221 W. Victory Way in Craig no later than 7 pm on Election Day, April 2, 2019.
