Position Objective:

To assist in routine general maintenance and/or upkeep of flowers in and around the city planted by the Parks/Recreation department from June to possibly October 1.

Duties and Responsibilities:

Planting, watering, fertilizing and removing dead flowers and weeds from planters located in and around the city limits. Must work most weekends and be able to work early mornings. Other duties as assigned.

Working Conditions:

Possible exposure to inclement weather, e.g., heat, sun, wind, rain, dust, cold, noise, etc. Possible exposure to chemicals such as fertilizers.

Mental Demands:

Must be able to follow instructions. Must have awareness of safety and adhere to safety policies. Must be able to work and make judgments independently.

Physical Demands:

Occasional heavy lifting up to 50 lbs. Standing, walking, bending, stooping, crawling, lifting, reaching, climbing ladders, etc.
