

## Winter Parking Regulations

The City of Craig currently does not have any parking regulations on our streets during the winter months.

However, the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) does! CDOT maintains the highways that run through Craig (Victory Way & from 4<sup>th</sup> Street up the byway) and we must abide by their parking regulations.

Below are the signs that you might notice along the highway. If a car is parked in a restricted area during these times, the state patrol will typically **red tag** those vehicles and allow the owner 24 hours to move their vehicle. If the vehicle has not been removed within the 24 hours given, the vehicle will be towed!

Please be aware of where you are parking your vehicle during these winter months to assist with snow removal operations.
